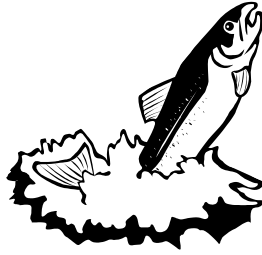


Woodhaven Fishing Ponds



The Fargo Park District, in cooperation with the ND Game and Fish Department, have stocked small water retention ponds in southwest Fargo's --

- **Woodhaven Pond — North** (44th Avenue and 43rd St. S., Fargo)
- **Woodhaven Pond — South** (48th Avenue and Woodhaven Drive S., Fargo)

Woodhaven Pond - North

Rainbow Trout - adult	450 (2006 - present)
Bluegills - adult	231 (2006)
Largemouth Bass - adult	24 (2006)

Woodhaven Pond - South

Perch - fingerlings & adult	900 (2007)

We had reports of very good trout fishing last summer and also bluegills being caught last winter. There were special events held at the north pond for Trout Fest (June) and a Youth Ice Fishing Derby (February).

Rules & regulations on back Anglers must possess a resident or nonresident ND fishing license — youth ages 15 and under do not need a ND fishing license. *North Dakota Game & Fish Department fishing and boating regulations apply. We encourage all anglers to practice catch-and-release practices. Other important regulations include:

- No illegal stocking (*state regulation*)
- No swimming (*city regulation*)
- No gas-powered motors are allowed —self propelled boats only (*city regulation*)
- Park is closed from dusk to dawn
