To All Captains, Team Managers & Players:

This letter is pertaining to some rule changes and roster items have been changed for the upcoming indoor soccer season that starts next week.

The following changes pertain to the 2011-12 season. These rules and team roster changes will be strictly enforced by the Indoor Soccer League Supervisors. These will be in effect for every league ( i.e. HS Boys, Men's ).

First, the **red card** enforcement has been changed. If one or more player's receives a red card in one of their league games that individual(s) will be suspended from playing the rest of that game and one more game in the league that they received a red card in. The team will also receive a (-1) for a player(s) which receive a red card in any indoor soccer league game. It will count as (-1) for however many of the players that are red carded. This will count to the overall number of points you receive for a win, tie or loss in your game for that week which could be costly when it came to seeding for the end of the year league tournament.

Second, only rostered players may be in the team boxes for games. That means every player(s) **MUST** be in uniform. If they are not they will not be allowed to be in the team box area. In order to play all players **MUST** sign the team roster before they play. The result of a player(s) not being on a team roster will result in a forfeit for that team for using an ineligible player(s).

Third, if during a league game two teams get out of control to where it becomes an issue, in the judgment of the officials they have every right to stop the game at any time and both teams will receive a loss on their overall record.

Fourth, if any player receives a red card they will be suspended from playing in the league in which they received a red card for one game. They will be able to play in other leagues with the team that they are on.

Lastly, the Fargo Park District will enforce **ZERO TOLERANCE** in the indoor soccer league this season. All players, captains, coaches and team managers will be held accountable for their actions and conduct towards league officials and referees.
